- 1. <u>Introduction:</u> The world today needs persons who are honest, virtuous, selfless and compassionate driven by sense of service and capable of exercising restraint despite extreme provocations; persons who can show the path of love and shower it freely without yearning for returns. To achieve this mission of our founding father Sant Attar Singh Ji Mastuane Wale Akal Academy Kollianwali was established in April, 2011 on Sito Road, District. Sri Muktsar Sahib. Our mission Statement reads: "To establish permanent peace in the world through value based scientific education and spiritual upliftment and provide solace and succor the down trodden and the deprived".
- 2. <u>Infrastructure:</u> The Academy owns a magnificent building comprising of 8 Class rooms 1 Special Rooms and an Admin Block. As many as 214 students are being provided Modern Scientific Education blended with spirituality to achieve excellence in whatever careers they choose for themselves. All Class rooms are equipped with modern teaching gadgets to serve the world class content on the students' platter within the four walls of class rooms. Apart from Computer Lab, Mathematics Lab, Art and Craft Room, Composite Science Lab, Music Room, Meditation Room and Kids Activity Room for students. A Grand Library with 3120 books & Resource books 1129 contains all types/ Subjects books with some rare scriptures on Sikh history. Nearly 8 Magazines and 3 Periodicals are a permanent feature of the school library. Neat and Clean Washrooms, purified drinking water and a clean and green campus provides peaceful environment for learning. One R.O. Systems with 500 Lt/hour capacities each have been installed to fulfill drinking water needs of students. A Genset of 24 KW capacities is available for the continuous supply of electricity in case of power failures.
- 3. <u>Faculty and Staff:</u> Nearly 16 teachers 2 Non-teaching members and 7 supporting staff members take care of the holistic development of the students with dedication and sincerity. Every year professional development workshops/ Conferences/ Seminars are organised to chisel and refine their talents in the interest of thestudents.
- 4. <u>Sports:</u> Students enjoy playing the sport of their choice in huge playfields equipped for playing Volleyball, Football, all types of athletics and Indoor games likes Ludo, Chess, Carom etc.

- 5. <u>Extra-Curricular Activities:</u> The students divided into four HOUSES namely ABHAY, AJAY, AMUL and ATUL are encouraged to participate in Creative Writing, Fine Arts, Debates, Declamation Contests, Penal Discussions, Power Point Presentations, Dramas, Storytelling and Dramatization, Choreographies, Religious Shabad Singing and other diverse Linguistic and Cultural Programmes of differentstates.
- 6. <u>National and International Olympiads:</u> The talent search programmes are organised throughout the session and students actively participate in National and International Olympiads in the subject of English, Mathematics, Science, G.K, Drawing, Art & Craft and Information Technology. We got 5 Gold, 3 Silver, 3 Bronze Medals. Master Arav Arora & Manveer Singh got National level position is **Scholar Hunt Competitive** exam.

7. Environment Sensitivity:

- The school owns an Eco Club with a membership of 50 students which undertakes following activities during every session:

 - (iv) Save Water / Electricity Project
 - (v) Rallies against Pollution, Straw Burning etc.
 - (vi) Cleanliness campaigns at Public Places.
- 8. Spiritual Uplistment: Ours is a day-boarding institution. The students spend the serene morning hour (35 to 40 minutes) in meditation (Nitnem, Shabad Kirtan) before morning assembly which enhance their religious faith, power of concentration, retention and provide solace to their souls. We organise different competitions and religious programmes to inculcate values, the quality of caring and sharing, helping the needy and shrramdaan which are the basic tenets of Sikhism: NaamJapo, KiratKaro, VandChhako.
- 9. <u>Educational Excursions:</u> The School organises educational tours and trips to Chhatbir Zoo, Science city Kapoorthla and different Gurdwara Sahib etc. to broaden the vision and interest of the Students. They are prepared to be future ready by organising Rallies and Road shows to attract their attention towards national and global issues like pollution, scarcity of Water, drugs etc.
- 10. <u>Concessions and Scholarships:</u> Taking care of the struggling humanity and helping the needy is the special feature of Akal Academies. Needy Students are enrolled under a variety of students' welfare schemes like Mata Bholi Ji Concession Scheme, Raagi-Paathi
